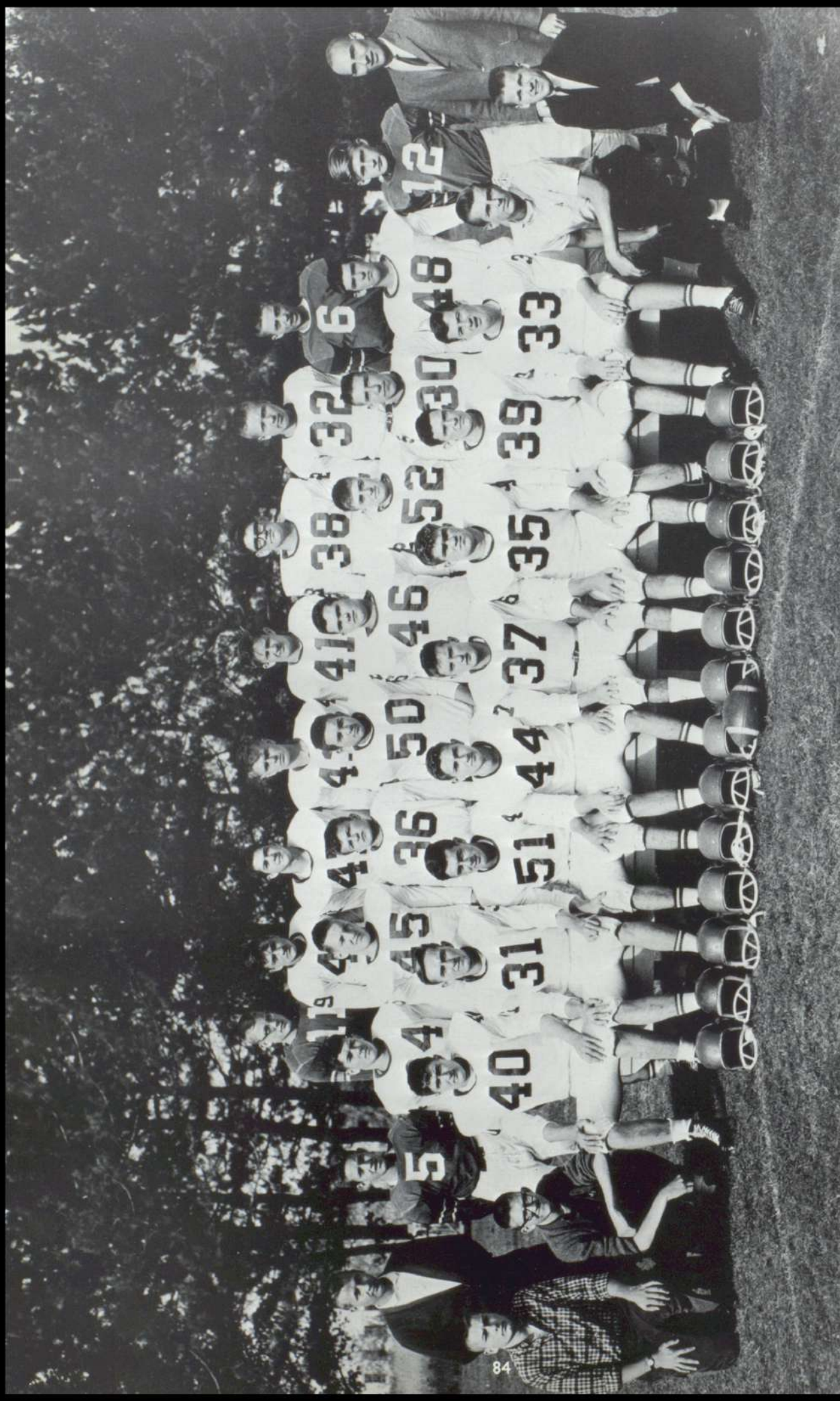
Sue then had to fill out a questionnaire and write an essay on "what loyalty means". This qualified her to enter in state competition.
