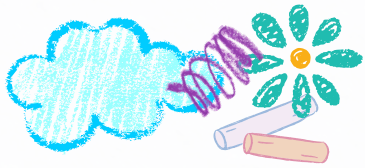

@ Maple Room--**PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED**--Come learn about fruits and veggies at this engaging program presented by FoodWise.



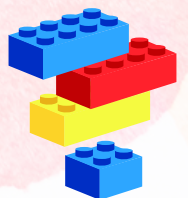

What we do:

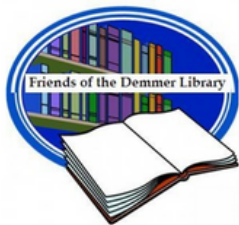
- *Initiates funding and endowment opportunities*
